Energy runs high at this signature annual event for the California Rangeland Trust, which raises significant funding to help ensure healthy working landscapes are available for future generations.


CALIFORNIA RANGELAND

California has very deep roots in ranching, and few know that some of the deepest beginnings were once in Orange County – known better today for its posh beaches and Disneyland adventures. With rapid growth happening in our state, we believe it is important to remember where many of us began.

From the earliest land stewardship traditions, running cattle along these scenic foothills has served to care for the land, build the backbone of local economies, and meet the needs of each new community.

Today, Rancho Mission Viejo is one of the last remaining working cattle ranches in the County. They continue to support a growing region by overseeing responsible and sustainable development that not only creates quality homes for Californians, but also provides opportunities to connect them to the region's natural spaces, our state's rich and deep diversity and multicultural legacies, and cowboy heritage.



In 2021, California Rangeland Trust will gather on the land at Rancho Mission Viejo to celebrate our ranching roots and the pivotal role ranching continues to play in the growth of healthy communities.


THE NEED TO CONSERVE WORKING LANDSCAPES

Over the last decade, 500,000 acres of rangeland were lost to development – imagine Los Angeles and San Diego combined! By 2050, California's population will top 60 million, and 2 million more acres will be lost.

The Rangeland Trust supports the ranching community in preserving grazing lands and ensuring a viable future for the agricultural industry in California. The beneficiaries of this work extend to people throughout our state through carbon sequestration and water storage services provided by well-managed rangelands, as well as the restorative views enjoyed along our scenic roadways. We remain committed to supporting the people who feed our communities, as well as to those who benefit from the value of open space here in California. This land, and the people who work it, will continue to give Californians so much more.

WHAT MAKES THE RANGELAND TRUST DIFFERENT?

There are more than 200 land trusts in California, and the Rangeland Trust is the only one working solely with the ranching community in our state. Our focus is to protect the unique resources on these properties with a holistic view of the needs of the people, livestock and wildlife that rely on them. With more than 340,000 acres already conserved, we've protected more working ranches than any other organization in our state. An ever-growing list of requests to work with us uniquely situates the Rangeland Trust to protect significant natural resources before they are gone forever.

The California Rangeland Trust works throughout our state to assist families who want to permanently protect their ranches and continue ranching. We have been an agricultural conservation leader since 1998 and are the largest land trust in California holding 95 easements on over 340,000 acres.
